Airline Transportation

Three airports are in close proximity to Ft Walton Beach:

Ft. Walton Beach Airport (12 miles) is serviced by: American, Continental, Delta, US Airways, and Vision Airways.

Panama City Airport (60 miles) is serviced by: Air Tran, American, Continental, Delta, Southwest, United, and US Airways.

Pensacola Airport (50 miles) is serviced by: Delta, Northwest, and US Airways.

Accommodations

The Best Western, Ft Walton Beachfront Hotel, 380 Santa Rosa Blvd., Ft. Walton Beach, Florida 32548, serves as the reunion host hotel.
